The YMCA Camp Counselor is responsible for leading the camper experience and enjoyment of an outdoor day camp for campers who have completed grades 4K-5th. The Camp Counselor provides quality childcare, fosters achievement, encourages belonging, and acts as an energetic, positive role model for children and staff, while creating age appropriate activities.

Required Knowledge:

- Experience working with school age children preferred.
- Requires high energy and an interest in planning and participating in fun and creative recreational and experiential activities with children.
- Requires ability to effectively interact with, lead and motivate children who have a variety of abilities and needs.
- Ability to create a safe and fun environment for campers to thrive.
- Positive attitude and creative thinking skills.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- High school diploma or equivalent required.
- Must have a minimum of 80 hours of Early Childhood classes OR completed at least 3 credits in Elementary Education, or Child Guidance, or Child Development
- Must pass First Aid and CPR training - WE WILL TRAIN
- Willingness and desire to work outdoors for up to 10 hours in all weather conditions with children

Physical Abilities and Working Conditions

- Ability to safely supervise children's activities both indoors and outdoors
- Ability to perform all physical aspects of the position that include hiking, bending, kneeling, stretching, reaching, jumping, jogging, dancing, swimming.
- Must be willing and able to participate in the water during aquatic activities.
